You may check in to Hotel du Pont after 3:00pm (EDT) on Wednesday, September 19 and must check out by 12:00pm (EDT) on Thursday, September 20. You may check your bags at the front desk or bring them to the room where plenary sessions are taking place.

Transportation

The closest airport to the CAN Summit is the Philadelphia International Airport. If you are traveling by rail, the closest station to the CAN Summit

is the Wilmington Amtrak Station. Please plan to be checked into the Hotel du Pont by 5:00pm (EDT) Wednesday evening. Return flights and trains should be booked for 6:30pm (EDT) or later on Thursday, September 19.

PARKING

The Hotel du Pont offers overnight valet parking for all CAN Summit attendees at the discounted rate of \$16.00 per night.
